

# Space Camp 2019

**11<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> May 2019**

Dear Parents/Guardians,

There are a few short weeks to go until the Beavers descend on Silverwood for Space Camp.

To make sure things run smoothly, please find below our overall plans.

## When

Saturday 11th May 2019 – drop off at the site at 10:00, please do not get to the site early as the Scouts will be finishing an overnight sleep out and you will cause traffic chaos if you are trying to get onto site while they are leaving. Arrival in full uniform please. Please pack all gear into one bag and make sure items are labelled.

Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> May 2019 – collection from the camp site at 15:00. Please ensure a leader knows that you have taken your child. If someone else will be collecting for you, please let us know in advance. If you need to collect earlier, please let us know in advance so we can make arrangements.

## Monies

## Where

We will be at Silverwood scout camp site. This is located on the right as you leave Silkstone, coming up the hill towards Dodworth, just before the bend and opposite the golf course. Note the road is a single track and uneven. Once on site please park in the car park and then walk over to the single-story building at the end of the track.

## Next steps

- A general consent form and a medical notification form will accompany this letter. Please complete and return these as soon as possible. If you complete it once you have printed it then e-mail them back after completion by scanning that will be great – we are trying out a new paperless scheme on our side. Smart phones can use an app to scan documents,
- Please do not pack any electronic devices.
- If possible, please bring two clean, empty 2 litre pop bottles for one of the activities, we will have some if you cannot bring them.

We will be sleeping in tents overnight; we have a building to use for some activities and for cooking, but this does not have any sleeping accommodation. Please ensure your sleeping bag is suitable for use outside (we recommend a 3-season bag) and you might like to use a blanket too.

## Kit list

- Sleeping bag
- Additional blanket(s) (if required)
- Roll mat (for sleeping on)
- Pillow (if desired)
- Pyjamas
- Enough suitable warm clothes for the duration of the trip
- Coat (we are outside most of the time)
- Torch
- Teddy
- Toothbrush, wash kit and towel
- Necker/Beaver Jumper (to be worn)
